The 2025 Tyler Bastian Field Session in Maryland Archeology will be held at the Teagues Point SIte (18CH1005) in Charles County from 23 May through 2 June. The excavation site is near Maxwell Hall Park approximately 6 miles from Hughesville, MD and 9 miles from Prince Frederick, MD. Hotels in Laplata or Waldorf, MD should be within a 30-minute drive to the site.
